IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

If possible, all accessories and manuals should be included. Most developing countries prefer equipment that is simple and easy to use. Non-electrical tables and equipment are preferred over equipment that is dependent upon electricity to operate. Equipment that requires electricity to operate should function on both 50 and 60 Hz or be easily convertible to different voltage and frequency inputs.

We care enough to send only the best supplies available. Please do not donate damaged, dirty, obsolete, or expired supplies.

MEDICAL SUPPLY NEEDS

- Absorbable hemostats
- Ace bandages
- Anesthesia supplies (face masks, manual resuscitators)
- Casting materials
- Catheters (suction, urinary)
- Dressings (gauze, bandages, Band-Aids, 4 x 4's, etc.)
- EKG supplies (electrodes, recording paper, leads, etc.)
- Electrosurgical supplies (cautery pencils, patient electrodes, etc.)
- Endotracheal and tracheal tubes
- Exam tables
- Gowns (surgical and exam)
- Gloves (surgical and exam)
- Hygiene Supplies (toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, etc.)
- Hospital Beds (crank only)
- IV supplies (catheter placement, butterflies, injection sites, extensions)
- Orthopedic supplies (braces, slings, supports, prosthetics)
- Patient care (wheelchairs, walkers, crutches)
- Scalpels and blades
- Scrub/prep (surgical scrub, iodine, brushes, sponges)
- Stainless steel containers
- Surgical instruments
- Surgical towels and drapes (cloth preferred)
- Surgical tape
- Sutures and wound closure supplies
- Syringes/needles
- Tongue depressors and containers
- Cotton tipped applicators and containers
