In the Dominican Republic, a generator which was an emergency purchase with funds from the Yes! Fund, is already helping ensure that medical care continues even when electricity does not. In places where power outages are common, this is not simply about convenience. It is about protecting patients, preserving medicines, and keeping the doors of ministry open.

In Zimbabwe, the Guta Clinic is expanding access to clean water and health education—simple things that dramatically change the health of entire communities. They have a focus on care for girls, who are often neglected in their culture.



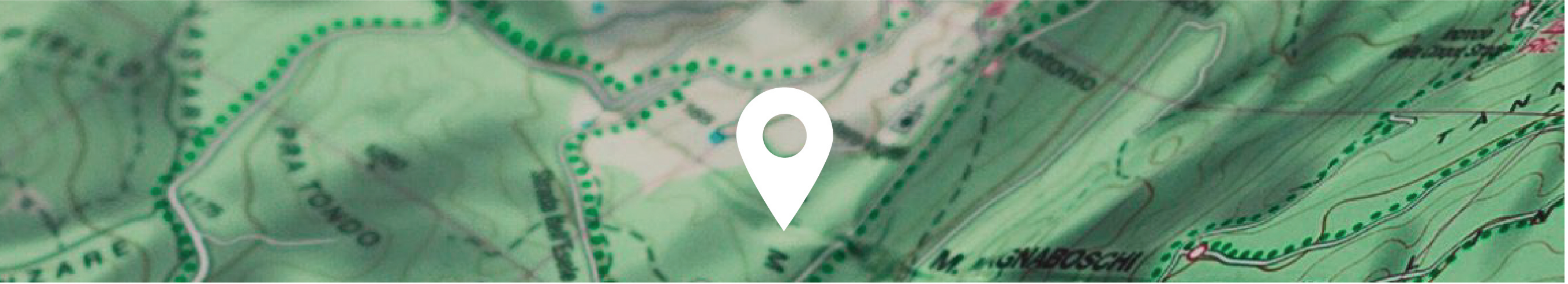
A refugee clinic on the

In Thailand, a new clinic is being equipped and furnished for refugee families, this is the second FAME clinic recently constructed on the Myanmar border in refugee settlements. Additionally, an ambulance will help reach refugees and remote communities transporting patients who otherwise may never make it to treatment.

Each of these projects has one thing in common: They increase the locations where moments of care occur.

Not just healthcare. Not just buildings. But places where people are cared for in the name of Christ.
